

Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief ESSER Funds Plan

In 2020 and 2021, Congress passed three stimulus bills to provide funding to the Elementary and Secondary Emergency Education Relief (ESSER) Fund. NYS must distribute Fund to local education agencies (LEAs) based on their proportional share of ESSA Title I-A funds. On March 11, 2021, The American Rescue Plan Act passed providing supplemental ESSER funding, known as ESSER III. ESSER funds are a one-time emergency relief payment, funding will expire after September 2024.

Classical Charter Schools (CCS) is using the ESSER fund to embrace in-person instruction. We strongly believe in-person settings are the best environment for learning and for social-emotional development for scholars. CCS provides support for students and takes corrective actions against any negative academic impact of COVID-19. CCS addresses learning loss and maintains the health and safety of students and school staff with close monitoring of vulnerable students. This includes low-income students, students with disabilities and students experiencing homelessness. The ESSER fund is a key support of CCS' extended learning tutoring opportunities, summer learning, developing specialized learning initiatives and interventions to enable students to overcome pandemic-driven learning gaps and meeting challenging academic standards.

CCS is utilizing the ESSER fund to upgrade and maintain proper health and safety precautions at school facilities to ensure air quality complies with current federal, state, and local regulations. We are updating, purchasing, and maintaining hardware and software for students, staff, and classrooms. Classrooms have been equipped with updated technology to accommodate in-person instruction, and increase technological supports and infrastructure for schools, including projectors, expanded WIFI access in buildings, improved cybersecurity. Specialized hardware supports remote, hybrid, and in -person learning classroom environments. CCS is committed to provide a safe environment for students and staff by implementing, onsite COVID-19 testing as long as it is required.

Accountability, financial transparency, commitment to governance practices and policies are the core of CCS. We are utilizing ESSER funds with financial efficiency, sustainability, and trustworthiness. See approved budgets for ESSER I, II & III below:
